

## Ever wondered what really happens in an artist's studio? Oxfordshire Artweeks is a great time to find out!

Hundreds of artist and makers from in and around Wallingford are throwing open their doors and welcoming you from the 6th-14th May. You'll find everything from paintings and pottery to installation and intrigue. This map is designed to help plan your route and decide which of the studios, venues and exhibitors to visit.

**The Clumps and surrounds:** In the vicinity of Wittenham Clumps you can see multiple venues in one afternoon and enjoy a long or short walk too. New venues for this year: The Earth Trust invites visitors to immerse themselves in nature whilst admiring the artwork of 6 exhibiting artists in their gallery, a beautiful converted 19th Century barn; and down the road on Sire Hill you'll find a delightful and intriguing venue, a traditional Mongolian Yurt showing paintings and textiles. There are many more beautiful studios and gardens within walking distance and at Marsh Baldon, Dorchester and Shillingford, showing paintings, mosaics, ceramics, sculpture and pottery! Check their listings for opening dates and times and plan your individual trail!

**Ewelme & Benson:** In Ewelme, Annual Artweeks exhibitors Harriet Coleridge (potter), Mary Lowry (weaver) and Debbie Farrell (textiles) will this year be joined by 'greenwood' carver Michael J Amphlett who practices the art of carving wooden wares ("treen"), such as spoons, shrink-pots, bowls and other small items from freshly cut wood.

Down the road in Benson, Geoffrey Harcourt, painter, retired designer and Artweeks regular says why he enjoys taking part each year.

*"Artweeks is superb for artists of all visual disciplines to share their joy of their craft to the public, who can be inspired to try it themselves or enjoy the artistry of ordinary people who love to*

*draw, paint, pot, weave or sculpt, and visitors might even get a cup of tea and biscuit or a glass of wine. What's not to like?"*

**Wallingford and surrounds :** Ayres House Studios will again be opening their studios, gallery and garden, sharing their work and processes with the public. Studio disciplines range from ceramics, painting, drawing, sculpture, performance, video, sound, installation, photography, print, textiles, conservation and writing. So who knows what works you might witness being created on your visit.

There is lots more to be seen in Wallingford Town this year, with many new venues on the map, with paintings from Fay Ford and Christine Bass, Jewellery by Kate Wilkinson and ceramics by Robyn Hardyman and newly opened pottery, The Potters Wheel! As well as many new venues, Wallingford Town Centre is hosting a Taster Art Trail, with shops and businesses sharing window displays of local Artists work.


Nearby in Brightwell and North Morton there are two group shows sharing the work of 13 artists and makers and their love for fine art and craft.

**Nuffield, Henley and Reading Area:** And just in case you thought that was all, the Wallingford Area stretches further than you think. At the new venue The Maker Space in Nuffield, you can see artworks, find out about workshops and enjoy the cafe. There is more to be seen from the RG postcode at Goring and North and South Stoke, Debbie Page's Moon Jars at her happy yellow Studio at Kidmore End and Landscapes by Jane Ford at Crays Pond. The trail ends at Henley at The Old Fire Station on The Marketplace with a group exhibition by Heritage & Hallmark.






